Crowd Sourcing the Trails of Philipstown

The Philipstown Community Congress Trails Committee seeks public input to help generate a map of all non-motorized trails in the area. The Trails Committee invites anyone to submit a visual representation of a non-motorized trail or trails in Philipstown or the surrounding area, such as a map or photograph, showing the route of the trail.

The Trails Committee will combine the public's trail-map crowd-sourcing with existing trail maps to create a comprehensive database and map of all Philipstown-area non-motorized trails, including walking, hiking, biking, riding and carriage trails. The Trails Committee's long-range goal is to help expand public access to and use of trails in the area.

Interested persons can view the current trail map the Committee has generated online at WEBSITE, which can help eliminate duplicate trail submissions.

The Committee seeks trail map submissions by June, 2018, and asks that they be sent via email to philipstowntrails@gmail.com as PDF or image or photograph files (e.g., jpeg).
