PHILIPSTOWN BIKES DAY 2021

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 9AM - NOON

(Philipstown, NY - Tuesday, August 24, 2021) - The Philipstown Trails Committee (PTC) is pleased to announce Philipstown Bikes Day 2021. With this event, the PTC hopes to encourage Philipstown residents to reduce their carbon footprint and practice a healthy active lifestyle. The fourth annual event is taking place Saturday, September 18 (rain date: Sept. 19). All are invited to join in the event and bicycle, walk or participate in any other non-motorized form. The event will be from 9AM to NOON and participants can join the loop anywhere, at any time.

Event Check-in with COVID-19 safety precautions in place will take place at the Elementary blacktop area of the Haldane Central School District at 15 Craigsides Drive, Cold Spring, NY and participants should check in at the sign-in table upon arrival.

To keep everyone as safe as possible, we will be taking the following precautions:

- The event will take place completely outdoors, with social distancing maintained at all times;
- There will be no official start time or closing event to minimize any congestion, with participants allowed to join the loop anytime between 9AM- NOON and from anywhere along the loop;
- All participants will be asked to wear a mask at check-in.

Participants who successfully complete the 1.6-mile circuit (SEE ATTACHED MAP) at least once will receive a commendation to recognize their participation in the event and support for a more bikeable and walkable community.

The committee gives thanks to the Villages of Cold Spring and Nelsonville, the Town of Philipstown, Haldane Central School District for supporting the event, and Downey Energy for allowing the use of their parking lot to ensure a safer bike route.

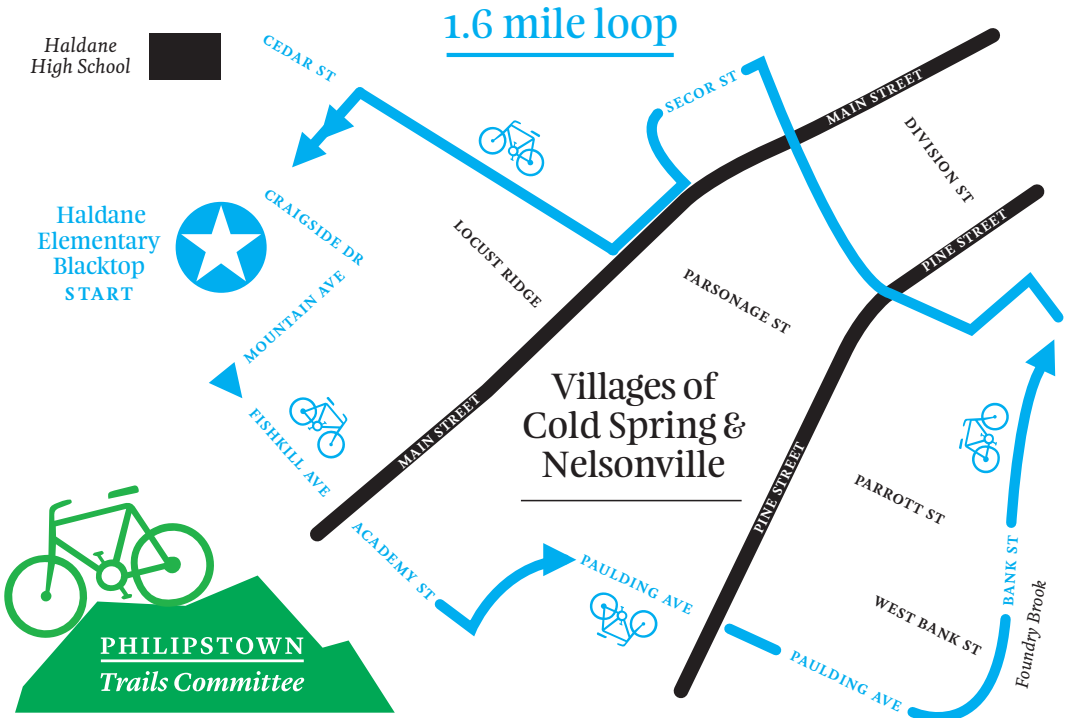
